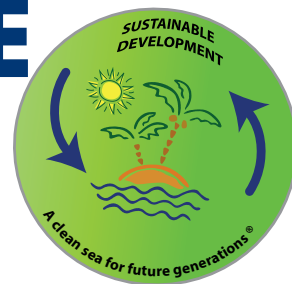


# COTTON KLINE

**COTTON KLINE** is a preparation based on alkaline salts, water softening agents, emulsifying ingredients to lower surface tension and vegetable extracts selected for their biodegradability.

**COTTON KLINE** is a specially designed soap for washing cotton and synthetic fibre awnings, biminis and tarpaulins.

**COTTON KLINE** acts rapidly without removing the impermeable protective film and leaves a pleasant fresh odour.

**COTTON KLINE** eliminates greases, mineral or vegetable oils, mildew or food deposits and carbon stains leaving no trace.

**COTTON KLINE** is miscible in ordinary water and in very hard water in any proportion.

**COTTON KLINE** has the following properties:

- Non-flammable
- Biodegradable
- Phosphate free.

### INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

- Lay the cloth over a flat surface.
- Dampen the textile with clean water.
- Add the **COTTON KLINE** and water solution (5 to 10 capfuls of product in 5 litres of water).
- Brush the cloth with a soft brush with rounded edges and leave the solution to act for several minutes.
- Take care not to crush the bristles of the brush on the textile surface.
- Rinse well.
- Repeat the operation on the other side of the textile.
- Then hang up the cockpit cover or protective awning until it is completely dry.
